

*Thank you for choosing Agua Linda Farm for your event!*

The farm is located an easy 30-minute drive south of Tucson International Airport and downtown Tucson. We are 25 minutes from the border with Mexico. Though technically part of Amado, the farm is actually just as close to the historic artist's community of Tubac, 5 miles south. Tubac is a tourist destination offering shops, art galleries, restaurants, the Anza Trail and museums. There are mini-marts with basic food and necessities close to the farm and the closest grocery store can be found 15 minutes north off Continental Road in Green Valley Arizona.

For local accommodations within 8 minutes of the farm, you may want to consider the following:

1. The Pocket Sanctuary at Kenyan Ranch in Tubac.

About 5 minutes south of us in the western foothills of Tubac, this is a wonderful old ranch with many adobe casitas. They usually do wellness retreats and seminars for groups but would love to host you and your guests. They have space for 50 guests (about 20 rooms), a pool, and great views - Arizona style charm. Rates run from about \$70 per room to \$110. They require a minimum of 15 people to reserve and want payment in one transaction. 2. The Floating Stone in Tubac.

Also 5 minutes south (but on other side of the freeway), this is new place that just opened. The Floating Stone is also a wellness retreat but is located right in the middle of historic Tubac - very cool because guests can walk to shops, museums, art galleries, walking trails along the Santa Cruz River and restaurants while also taking advantage of the lovely pools/spas that the facility has. The main building is a Tubac historic site onto which more facilities have been very tastefully added. The main facility can fit 18 guests with rooms and a house on site. About a 3/10ths of a mile walk away are 6 more rooms - with kitchens - that can fit 12 more guests. The main site does not allow children (because of pools), but the additional 6 rooms do. 3. Amado Territory Inn B&B

The closest place to stay, this bed and breakfast is about a 5-minute drive north of the farm on the Frontage Road (you do not have to get on the freeway to get there from here). There are 9 rooms available and a house. Mention Agua Linda Farm
